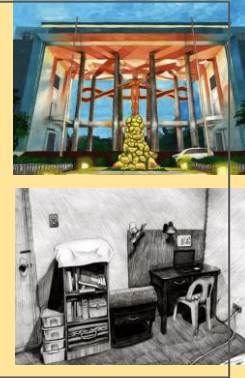
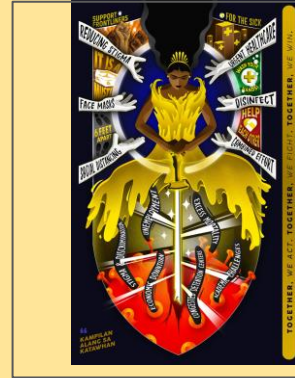
I Gilbert Matthew D. Rayco, a 4th year Landscape Architecture student. Nice to meet you!

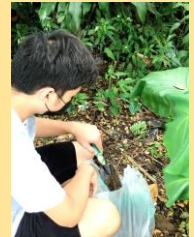

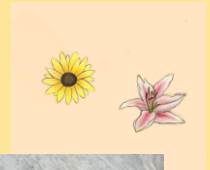

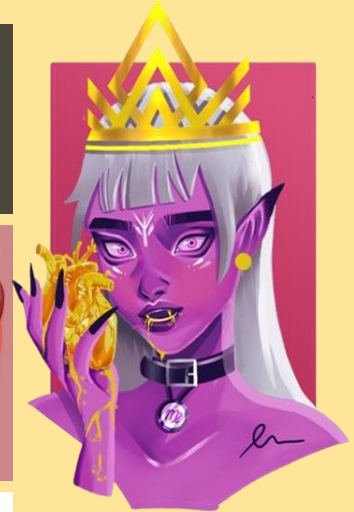

Hello! My name is Ivan Rio Leon Queñano, a 3rd year Computer Engineering student at UP Diliman.

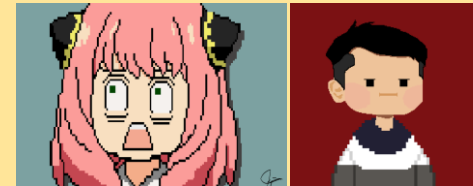

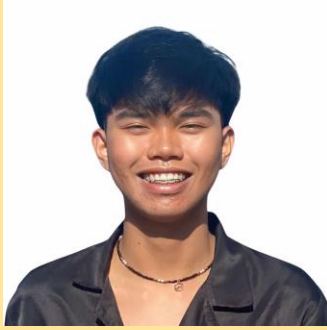

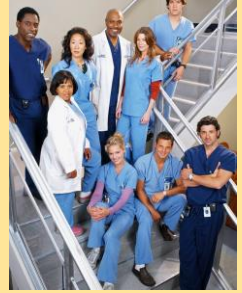


Our new UPAABC scholar **John Ruiz Magdaet** is from UP College of Engineering
